

GORDAN GULAN, full time professor at the Faculty of Medicine, University of Rijeka, orthopedics specialist, subspecialist in musculoskeletar traumatology. Born in 1964 in Zagreb, graduated from the Faculty of Medicine, University of Rijeka in 1989. The Master of science qualification received in 1995 and Ph.D. in 2000 at the Faculty of Medicine, University of Rijeka with a dissertation titled "Role of lymphocytic subpopulations in rheumatoid arthritis".

As an assistant he was employed at the Department of Physiology and Immunology at the Faculty of Medicine in Rijeka, and since 1995 has been employed at the Clinic for Orthopaedic Surgery Lovran. Currently holds the position of the head of the Orthopedic Department. President of the Croatian Society for Sports Traumatology and Arthroscopy. The area of narrow scientific and professional interests is knee, hip and shoulder diseases.

He is a collaborator in several domestic scientific projects. He was a mentor in 3 master's and 6 doctoral dissertations. So far he has published over 100 scientific and professional papers and abstacts in international conference proceedings. He has been the organizer of numerous scientific and professional conferences and the head of several arthroscopic workshops. He was awarded as the Best Young Scientist in Clinical Sciences at the Faculty of Medicine, University of Rijeka in 2000, and received two awards as the active participant in the international congresses.
