Diplomirao je na Veterinarskom fakultetu Sveučilišta u Zagrebu 1999. godine te doktorirao 2007. godine obranivši disertaciju "Filogenetska i antigenska analiza izolata virusa influence konja izdvojenih u Hrvatskoj (Phylogenetic and antigenic analysis of equine influenza viruses isolated in Croatia)".

Na Veterinarskom fakultetu Sveučilišta u Zagrebu zaposlen je od 2001. godine, gdje radi i danas na Zavodu za mikrobiologiju i zarazne bolesti s klinikom.

Na matičnoj ustanovi obnašao je dužnosti pročelnika Odjela te prodekan.

Autor je ili koautor više od 150 bibliografskih jedinica, mentor dvije disertacije te voditelj i suradnik na više nacionalnih i međunarodnih znanstvenih projekata.

Dobitnik je nagrade AMZH "Borislav Nakić" 2010. godine, a za redovitog člana AMZH izabran je 2018. godine.

Ljubo Barbić, full professor at the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine University of Zagreb, was born on November 29th 1974 in Imotski. He has graduated in 1999 at the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, University of Zagreb and in 2007 earned his PhD with thesis "Phylogenetic and antigenic analysis of equine influenza virus isolates isolated in Croatia". He got his first position at the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine in 2002 and currently he is working at the Department of Microbiology and Infectious Diseases with Clinic. He has been Head of Division and Vice Dean on Faculty of Veterinary Medicine. As main author or co-author he published more than 150 scientific papers and has been mentor of two PhD students and member of the research groups in several international scientific projects so far. In 2010 he was awarded a "Borislav Nakic" prize and since 2018 he has become a full member of the Croatian Academy of Medical Science.
