Na Stomatološkom fakultetu Sveučilišta u Zagrebu diplomirao (1973.), magistrirao (1977.) i doktorirao (1980.); disertacija "Vrednovanje morfološko-rendgenoloških nalaza u mješovitoj denticiji s posebnim osvrtom na prerani gubitak zubi i njihove poslijedice." Specijalistički ispit iz ortodoncije (1977.) godine.

Radio je u Domu zdravlja Poreč (1973. – 1992.), te na Medicinskom fakultetu u Rijeci (1984. - 2012). Sada radi u privatnoj Poliklinici za stomatologiju Legović u Poreču, kao voditelj Poliklinike i specijalist ortodoncije.

Područje znanstvenog interesa: ortodoncija i orofacialna genetika.

(1977) and Ph.D. (1980); title of dissertation „Evaluation of morphological endogenous findings in mixed dentition with a particular reference to premature tooth loss and its consequences“. Specialist in orthodontics from 1977.

His previous affiliations include Health Center Poreč (1973 - 1992) and Faculty of Medicine University of Rijeka (1984 - 2012). He is currently working as the head of the Dental Polyclinic Legović and specialist in orthodontics, Poreč.

Research interests: orthodontics and orofacial genetics. He has directed several research projects, has been advisor of 12 M.Sc. and 4 Ph.D. students, and has published 70 scientific (15 CC) and professional articles.
