Rođen 1942. godine u Zagrebu. Diplomirao 1966. a doktorirao 1974. na Medicinskom fakultetu, te magistrirao 1968. na Prirodoslovno-matematičkom fakultetu Sveučilišta u Zagrebu; 1972. doktorat specijalizacije bioantropologije, Université Paris VII, Pariz, Francuska. Naslov disertacije: «Odnos širine nosne šupljine prema interorbitalnoj udaljenosti – Funkcionalna kranijalna analiza».

Obnosi dužnost glavnoga tajnika HAZU (2011-2018); u Institutu za antropologiju kojeg je osnivač obavljao dužnost ravnatelja (1992-2011).

Područje znanstvenog interesa: antropologija, populacijska i molekularna genetika.

Voditelj domaćih i međunarodnih znanstvenih projekata, 35 mentorstva doktorandima, objavio preko 300 znanstvenih i stručnih radova.

**PAVAO RUDAN**, Fellow of the Croatian Academy of Sciences and Arts, full professor of anthropology; scientist emeritus of the Institute for Anthropological Research in Zagreb.

Born 1942 in Zagreb. Graduated in 1966 and received doctoral degree in 1974 from the Faculty of Medicine of the University of Zagreb. Master's degree in 1968 at the Faculty of Science of the University of Zagreb. Degree in specialised field of biological anthropology: 1972 at the Université Paris VII, Paris, France. Title of doctoral dissertation: "Relation between the Nasal Width and the Inter-Orbital Distance – Functional Cranial Analysis".

Current Secretary-General of the Croatian Academy of Sciences and Arts (2011–2018); founder and former Director of the Institute for Anthropological Research (1992–2011).

Scientific fields of interest: anthropology; population and molecular genetics.

Principal investigator of numerous national and international scientific projects; mentor to 35 doctoral candidates; published more than 300 scientific and professional papers.
