



Dušanka Martinović Kaliterna: Rođena u Splitu 20. veljače 1953. Profesor je Emeritus Sveučilišta u Splitu od 2021., redoviti je član AMZH od 2016. Bila je pročelnica Zavoda za reumatologiju i kliničku imunologiju, Interne klinike, KBC Split do 2018. Utemeljitelj i voditelj Referentnog Centra za Sustavnu Sklerozu Ministarstva zdravlja HR do 2018. Umirovljena je 2020. kao redovita profesorica u trajnom zvanju Medicinskog fakulteta, Sveučilišta u Splitu. Svoj profesionalni interes kao i područje istraživanja usmjerila je prema autoimunim bolestima te je kreirala brojne doktorske disertacije upravo iz tog područja. Godinama je bila aktivna u organizaciji međunarodnih znanstvenih sastanaka i edukacijskih tečajeva iz područja reumatologije i kliničke imunologije u Hrvatskoj i dijelom u Evropi. Bila je članica nacionalnih etičkih povjerenstava, također je bila predsjednica etičkog povjerenstva MEF Split (2015-2017). Članica je EUSTARA (evropske udruge za istraživanje sustavne skleroze) od 2002, članica izvršnog odbora EUSTARA od 2016 do 2019. te je višegodišnji predavač na međunarodnim edukacijskim tečajevima EUSTARA. Potakla je i pomagala osnivanje udruga bolesnika oboljelih od autoimunih bolesti u Hrvatskoj. Bila je predsjednica splitske podružnice HLZ od 2013 do 2021. Začasni je član HLZ i dobitnik nagrade "Ladislav Rakovac" za doprinos medicinskoj znanosti u Hrvatskoj. Autor je i koautor 11 knjiga i preko 100 međunarodno indeksiranih radova.

Dušanka Martinović Kaliterna: Born in Split on 20 the February 1953. She is professor Emeritus of University of Split since 2021 and also Full member of Academy of Medical Sciences Croatia since 2016. She was the Head of the Division of Rheumatology and Clinical immunology, Internal Clinic, Clinical Hospital Centre Split until 2018. She was founder and leader of Referral Centre of the Ministry of Health and Social Care for Systemic Sclerosis CHC Split until 2018. She is retired as Full Professor of Internal medicine, rheumatology and immunology at School of Medicine, University of Split in 2020. Her main interest and field of scientific work were autoimmune diseases so she created the PHD thesis of her students in this area. For many years she has been active in organization of international scientific meeting and educational courses of this field in Croatia and partly in Europe. She was involved in national ethic committees and she was also the president of ethic commit of Medical school, University of Split (2015-2017). She is member of EUSTAR from 2002, through which she participates as an international teacher on regular courses. She was the board member of EUSTAR (2016-2019). She initiated and supported patient's organizations for autoimmune diseases in Croatia. She was the president of Croatian Medical Association (CMA) Branch Split (2013-2021), awarded by "Ladislav Rakovac" for her contribution in medical science in Croatia and also by Honourable membership of CMA. She is author and co-author of 11 books and more than 100 internationally indexed papers.
