



Anna Mrzljak redovita je profesorica na Medicinskom fakultetu Sveučilišta u Zagrebu te hepatologinja i voditeljica Centra za transplantaciju jetre Kliničkog bolničkog centra Zagreb. Diplomirala je na Medicinskom fakultetu Sveučilišta u Zagrebu, gdje je i doktorirala iz područja transplantacijske medicine. Nositeljica je titula European Board of Transplant Medicine i European Board of Gastroenterology and Hepatology. Znanstveno i stručno usavršavala se u Institute for Liver Studies, King's College Hospital u Londonu te u Hannoveru. Voditeljica je ili suradnica u više nacionalnih i međunarodnih projekta iz područja virusnih hepatitisa, MASLD-a i transplantacije jetre, a aktivno je sudjelovala u izradi (inter)nacionalnih smjernica za virusne hepatitise, MASLD, portalnu hipertenziju i transplantaciju jetre. Autorica je više od 130 znanstvenih radova, a za svoj znanstveni doprinos medicini 2019. godine nagrađena je nagradom Hrvatske liječničke komore, a dobitnica je i UNESCO nagrade „Za žene u znanosti“. Trenutačno obnaša dužnost Senior Secretary Europskog odbora za transplantacijsku medicinu (UEMS). Članica je ELITA odbora Europskog društva za transplantaciju organa (ESOT), Odbora za članstvo i komunikaciju ILTS-a, Edukacijskog odbora Europskog društva za bolesti jetre (EASL) i Nacionalnog povjerenstva za transplantaciju solidnih organa Republike Hrvatske, te predsjednica Povjerenstva za izradu kliničkih smjernica i kontinuiranu medicinsku edukaciju Hrvatskog liječničkog zbora i Nacionalnog povjerenstva za specijalističko usavršavanje doktora medicine MIZ-a.

Anna Mrzljak is a Full Professor at the University of Zagreb School of Medicine and a hepatologist and Head of the Liver Transplant Center at University Hospital Centre Zagreb. She graduated from the University of Zagreb School of Medicine, where she also obtained a PhD in Transplantation Medicine. She holds board certifications from the European Board of Transplant Medicine and the European Board of Gastroenterology and Hepatology. She completed her scientific and professional training at the Institute for Liver Studies, King's College Hospital in London, as well as in Hannover, Germany. She has served as a principal investigator or collaborator on several national and international projects in the fields of viral hepatitis, MASLD, and liver transplantation, and has actively contributed to the development of national and international clinical guidelines on viral hepatitis, MASLD, portal hypertension, and liver transplantation. She is the author of more than 130 scientific publications. In 2019, she received the Croatian Medical Chamber Award for her scientific contributions to medicine and is also a recipient of the UNESCO Award “For Women in Science.” She currently serves as Senior Secretary of the European Board of Transplant Medicine (UEMS). She is a member of the ELITA Board of the European Society for Organ Transplantation (ESOT), the ILTS Membership and Communication Committee, the EASL Education Committee, and the National Solid Organ Transplantation Committee of the Republic of Croatia, and serves as Chair of the Committee for Clinical Guidelines and Continuing Medical Education of the Croatian Medical Association and of the National Board for Specialist Training of Medical Doctors.
