



Tikvica Luetić Ana, izv. prof. dr. sc.

Osnovnoškolsko i srednješkolsko obrazovanje završila je u Dubrovniku. Medicinski fakultet u Zagrebu privela je kraju sa prosječnom ocjenom 4,81, te je bila među 10% najuspješnijih studenata. Za vrijeme studija bila je demonstrator na katedrama za anatomiju i fiziologiju, te sudjelovala u organizaciji nekolicine studentskih kongresa. Na trećoj godini studija primila je nagradu iz patofiziologije za “extraordinary and unique curiosity for the subject and the cum laude fulfilment of the exam requirements”.

Obavezni pripravnički staž odradila je u Kliničkoj bolnici “Sestre milosrdnice”, te odmah nakon toga 2005. godine položila državni

ispit. Od 2005. godine radila je kao znanstveni novak- asistent na Katedri za anatomiju i u Laboratoriju za mineralizirana tkiva, Medicinskog fakulteta u Zagrebu. Već tada je radom u pretkliničkim istraživanjima duboko zašla u problematiku endokrinologije, naročito postmenopauze i osteoporoze. Sudjelovala je u organizacijama nekolicine međunarodnih znanstvenih skupova i izlagala na istim. Na Europskom simpoziju za mineralizirana tkiva dobila je nagradu za prezentaciju koja se tiče endokrinologije koštanog tkiva, tj. mogućoj terapiji osteoporoze koja nastaje u menopauzi. Sudjelovala je u nekoliko međunarodnih znanstvenih projekata iz čega je proizašla i njena doktorska disertacija, također na temu hormonskog utjecaja na koštanu fiziologiju. Usavršavala se na nekoliko europskih sveučilišta, te je takvo pretkliničko iskustvo izuzetno važno kao temelj kvalitetnog rada kasnije u klinici i s pacijentima. Od 2007. započela je obavljati specijalizaciju iz ginekologije i porodništva na Klinici za ginekologiju i porodništvo, Kliničke bolnice Sveti Duh, te položila specijalistički ispit u svibnju 2013. godine, te od tada u kontinuitetu radi kao specijalist ginekologije i porodništva. Još tijekom specijalizacije napisala je destetak znanstvenih radova, uglavnom na temu primjene ultrazvuka u ginekologiji i porodništvu koji su objavljeni u prestižnim svjetskim časopisima. Autorica je nekoliko knjiga, kao i nekolicine poglavlja u znanstvenim knjigama, kao i u knjigama namjenjenim široj publici. Tijekom specijalizacije naročito se bavila fetalnim ponašanjem kojeg se može pratiti 2D i 3D/4D ultrazvukom, o čemu je također pisala i izlagala na domaćim i stranim znanstvenim skupovima. Tijekom specijalizacije završila je i stručni poslijediplomski studij o primjeni ultrazvuka u ginekologiji i porodništvu, te tako stekla titulu sveučilišne magistre. Kao specijalistica godinama je radila u ambulantama specijaliziranim za trudnice, visokorizičnoj trudničkoj ambulanti, ginekološkoj ambulanti, onkološkoj ambulanti, kolposkopskoj ambulanti, te se bavila i postmenopauzalnom medicinom. Od 2016. godine započela je užu specijalizaciju, tj. subspecijalizaciju iz humane reprodukcije i endokrinologije, te se od tada subspecijalistički bavi neplodnošću. Treba napomenuti kako se usavršavala na različitim klinikama za neplodnost u Hrvatskoj i Europi. Također je završila nekoliko tečajeva o metodama tzv. prirodne plodnosti u kojima se pokušava restorirati reproduktivno zdravlje para. Navedenu kombinaciju znanja konvencionalne medicine humane reprodukcije i drugačijeg pristupa prirodne plodnosti smatra se velikim kapitalom znanja kojeg koristi u svakodnevnom radu s pacijentima. 2014. godine izabrana je u znanstveno zvanje znanstvenog suradnika u znanstvenom području biomedicine i zdravstva- polje kliničke medicinske znanosti na Medicinskom fakultetu u Zagrebu, a 2020. u znanstveno zvanje višeg znanstvenog suradnika. 2016. godine izabrana je u znanstveno-nastavno zvanje docenta na Odjelu za sestriinstvo, Hrvatskog katoličkog sveučilišta (HKS) u Zagrebu. Trenutno predaje nekoliko kolegija na studijima medicine, sestriinstva i primaljstva, te je voditelj izbornog kolegija “Neplodnost: pošast današnjice” koji je uvijek rado biran od strane studenata. Na fakultetu je također bila nositelj znanstvenog projekta o ulozi ultrazvuka u ginekologiji. Mentor je nekolicine studentskih diplomskih i završnih radova, te je redovito odlično ocjenjena od strane studenata. 2024. godine priznat joj je naslov primarijusa. Članica je mnogobrojnih strukovnih i stručnih liječničkih organizacija, te redovito recenzira domaće i međunarodne znanstvene publikacije. Sudjeluje u izobrazbi mladih liječnika i specijalizanata. Rado se odaziva pozivima za stručna izlaganja na radiju, televiziji i drugim medijima, najviše sa svrhom promicanja brige o ginekološkom zdravlju. Na godišnjoj razini redovito prima nagrade najboljeg ginekologa prema izboru pacijenta.

Tikvica Luetić Ana grew up in Dubrovnik, where she finished primary and secondary school. She graduated from the Medical School of the University of Zagreb with the GPA of 4, 81, finishing among 10 % top students. During her studies, she worked as a student assistant at the Departments for Anatomy and Physiology and participated in the organization of several student congresses. In her junior year, she received an award in pathophysiology for an “extraordinary and unique curiosity for the subject and the cum laude fulfillment of the exam requirements”. She completed her mandatory internship at the clinical hospital “Sestre milosrdnice” in Zagreb, and passed the professional state exam in 2005. Upon completing her internship, she worked as a junior research fellow and assistant at the Department for Anatomy and the Laboratory for Mineralized Tissues at the Medical School of the University of Zagreb. During her preclinical work and research, she took a particular interest in endocrinology, especially postmenopause and osteoporosis. She participated in the organisation of several international scientific congresses, where she also presented the results of her scientific research. At the European Symposium for Mineralised Tissues (2007), she received an award for the presentation of her research in the endocrinology of the bone tissue, i.e. possible treatments of postmenopausal osteoporosis. She took part in several international scientific research projects, which resulted in her doctoral dissertation on hormonal influences on bone physiology and the skeletal system. She underwent professional training at several European universities, considering such preclinical experience extremely important in laying foundations for successful clinical work with patients. In 2007, she started her OB/GYN residency at the Clinic for Obstetrics and Gynecology at the clinical hospital “Sveti Duh”, where she took her residency exam in 2013. She has been working continually as a specialist in obstetrics and gynecology ever since. During her residency, she published over ten scientific papers in renowned international journals, predominantly on the role and application of ultrasound in obstetrics and gynecology. She is the author of several books and chapters in academic and popular science books. During her residency, she tracked and researched fetal behavior using 2D and 3D/4D ultrasound, which resulted in multiple publications and presentations in national and international scientific congresses. During her residency period, Ana graduated from the postgraduate specialist study on the application of ultrasound in obstetrics and gynecology, earning the degree of university specialist. Her work experience as an OB/GYN specialist includes clinical work in day clinics for pregnancy, high-risk pregnancy, general gynecology, oncology, colposcopy and postmenopausal medicine. In 2016, Ana started her sub-specialization in human reproduction and endocrinology. Infertility is the primary scope of her subspecialty clinical work at the anti-sterility day clinic at the clinical hospital “Sveti Duh”. She underwent professional clinical training at several infertility clinics in Croatia and Europe and she also completed several courses on the methods of the so-called natural fertility, which aims to restore the reproductive health in couples. She considers the combination of conventional medicine of human reproduction and alternative approaches to natural fertility her greatest advantage in her everyday work with patients. Most of her professional clinical work involves pregnancy healthcare, delivery room experience and minimally invasive OB/GYN surgery. In 2014, she was elected research associate in the scientific field of biomedicine and healthcare - field of clinical medical science at the Medical School of the University of Zagreb, and a senior research associate in 2020. She became an assistant professor at the Department for Nursing at the Catholic University of Croatia (HKS) in Zagreb in 2016. She teaches obstetrics and gynecology at the Medical school of HKS, and she is the teacher in charge for the elective course “Infertility as a Contemporary Epidemic”, which regularly attracts a large number of students. She was also in charge of the university science project on the role of ultrasound in gynecology. Ana has also mentored multiple undergraduate and graduate theses, and has received excellent grades in teacher evaluation surveys. She is an active member of many professional medical associations and a peer reviewer for numerous national and international scientific publications. She participates in the training of young doctors and residents and also gladly accepts the opportunity to share her professional knowledge, opinions and comments in the media, primarily with the purpose of promoting women’s healthcare. She often receives patients’ choice annual awards for the best gynecologist.
