Zlatko Trkanjec je rođen 17.12.1958. u Virovitici. Diplomirao je na 1982. godine na Medicinskom fakultetu Sveučilišta u Zagrebu, specijalizaciju iz neurologije obavio je u OB Varaždin i u KB "Sestre milosrdnice", 1991. godine je magistrirao, a 1999. godine obranio doktorsku dizertaciju na Medicinskom fakultetu Sveučilišta u Zagrebu. 2008. godine izabran je za znanstvenog savjetnika, a 2014. za redovitog profesora u trajnom izboru na Katedri za neurologiju Stomatološkog fakulteta Sveučilišta u Zagrebu.

Od 1986. radi kao liječnik u Bolnici za plućne bolesti i tbc Klenovnik, a od 1996. godine kao neurolog na Klinici za neurologiju Kliničkog bolničkog centra "Sestre milosrdnice" u Zagrebu. Njegov klinički i istraživački interesi su neurodegenerativni poremećaji, posebno Parkinsonova i Alzheimerova bolest, te cerebrovaskularne bolesti. Objavio je više od 300 radova u domaćim i međunarodnim časopisima, te više od 20 knjiga i poglavlja u knjigama i udžbenicima.

Zlatko Trkanjec was born on 17.12.1958. in Virovitica. He graduated in 1982 from the School of Medicine, University of Zagreb, and completed his specialization in neurology at the General Hospital Varaždin and the Sestre milosrdnice University Hospital. In 1991 he received his master's degree and in 1999 he defended his doctoral dissertation at the School of Medicine, University of Zagreb. In 2008 he was elected as a scientific advisor, and in 2014 as a full professor in permanent election at the Department of Neurology, School of Dental Medicine, University of Zagreb.

Since 1986, he has been working as a doctor at the Hospital for Lung Diseases and TB Klenovnik, and since 1996 as a neurologist at the University Department of Neurology, Sestre milosrdnice University Hospital Center in Zagreb. His clinical and research interests are neurodegenerative disorders, especially Parkinson's and Alzheimer's diseases, and cerebrovascular diseases.

He has published more than 300 papers in domestic and international journals, and more than 20 books and chapters in books and textbooks.
